

**Interested in volunteering?** Volunteer candidates should meet the following criteria:

- **Age:** Volunteer applicants should be 18 years of age or older. Junior Volunteer applicants (16-17 years of age) may be considered to meet a specialized need in the hospital.
- **Commitment:** Because of the amount of orientation and training involved, we request a minimum 100-hour/6-month commitment from our volunteers (approximately one 4-hour shift per week for six months). Regular attendance is essential—minimum 75% average.
- **Background Check:** St. Mark's Hospital requires a background check on prospective volunteers. Paperwork is completed at the time of the interview. Your background check must clear before being scheduled for Hospital Orientation (takes 5-9 days). Junior volunteers need parental permission for the background check and are also requested to provide 2 letters of recommendation, proof of current GPA, and proof of age.
- **Hospital Orientation:** Each volunteer is required to attend the Hospital's one-day Orientation program before beginning volunteer service. It is generally held every other Monday from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm. Volunteers are scheduled for Hospital Orientation once they have completed the interview process and background check has cleared.
- **Orientation to Volunteer Services:** This provides more specific volunteer orientation and an introduction to your assigned area. It takes approximately 2 hours and is scheduled on Wednesday or Thursday following hospital orientation (or at a time convenient to your schedule).
- **General Health Review:** Each new volunteer must complete tuberculosis (TB) testing and meet with the Employee Health Nurse to complete a general health questionnaire and provide current vaccination information. This takes approximately 15 minutes and is scheduled as part of the Orientation to Volunteer Services.
- **Shifts:** Volunteer shifts generally run 8:30 am - 12:30 pm (morning), 12:30 - 4:30 pm (afternoon), and 4:30 - 8:00 pm (evening). Emergency Department shifts are 9 am to 1 pm, 2 – 6 pm, and 6 – 10 pm.
